Dear Parents and Carers,

I am delighted to confirm that we will be welcoming all our children back to school on Monday 8<sup>th</sup> March. Please see below for details. I would like to thank you, once again, for your continued support during this difficult time.

### **Staggered start/end to the day.**

To reduce the number of social interactions and risk of Infection, it is still necessary to have a staggered start and end to the day. Please refer to the table below for your child's timings. Children will continue to be greeted at the gate, each morning by their teacher and teachers will bring their classes to the gate, at the end of the day, to meet parents and carers, as they did in the Autumn term. The same arrangements will be in place for siblings.

***All parents and carers need to wear a face mask when bringing and collecting children please.***

All Year 3 children need to be brought to school and collected by a responsible adult please. If you would like your child in years 4, 5 and 6 to walk home alone, please email the admin email address to let us know as parents are responsible for their own child, once they leave the school premises. I am sorry to say that parents and carers are still not allowed on the school premises, until further notice. If any parents need to see a member of staff, to discuss anything at length, they must make an appointment via the Academy Office and wear a face covering if they are invited into school.

### **Breakfast Club and After School Club**

Unfortunately, we are not able to provide a breakfast club or an after school club until there is a further lifting of certain restrictions.



## Lunches

The same lunch arrangements as the Autumn term will be in place when the Academy fully opens; children will have a choice of hot meals, jacket potatoes and sandwiches each day or they can bring a packed lunch from home.

## Snacks

We are still not able to provide snacks so please could you send your child with a healthy snack for break time.

## Water Bottles

Please send your child with a full water bottle each morning. Water fountains are out of use but children will be able to re-fill their water bottles. If your child requires a new water bottle, please contact the Academy Office.

## Uniform

Children will need to wear their full school uniform on their return. If your child requires any new items, please refer to our website or contact the Academy Office.

## PE and Forest School

Children will continue to take part in both PE and Forest School at some point each week but they will still not be able to bring kit to school to change into. Please see below for the timetable so children can come to school dressed in their uniform PE kit or their Forest School clothes. I would like to remind everyone that on PE days children must wear their uniform PE kit with their school jumper and a pair of black or grey jogging bottoms or track suit bottoms over the top. Jeans must not be worn for PE or Forest School as they are not suitable for either lesson.
